COOPER TREWIN FOUNDATION

The Cooper Trewin Foundation emerged following the tragic loss of Cooper Trewin on February 6, 2010, at the tender age of 16 months. Cooper's sudden and unexplained passing prompted the establishment of the foundation, dedicated to supporting research into the underlying causes of such unexpected deaths in children.

As parents, receiving the news from a pathologist after an autopsy that our seemingly healthy little boy had no apparent illness, injury, or disease left us with myriad unanswered questions. In response, we decided to initiate research efforts, aiming to contribute to the discovery of a cause for such heartbreaking events.

From its modest beginnings, we have witnessed Brighter Days evolve into the iconic Australian festival it is today, a testament to the dedicated efforts of numerous volunteers. The funds raised through Brighter Days have directly contributed to saving children's lives, supporting initiatives such as the Cooper Trewin Brighter Days Neuroimaging Study, Brighter Days Genetic Screening, and a Safe Sleep Program based at Bairnsdale Hospital.

We are making a tangible difference, and through this research, Cooper is playing a vital role in changing the world. We express our gratitude for your efforts in fundraising for these meaningful charities, helping to preserve Cooper's legacy.

Funds are allocated by an independent Scientific Advisory Board. We've come a long way since our humble beginnings thanks to all of our loyal partners, like Brighter Days and supporters and look to continue leading the way in research programs, and making treatments readily available in Australia.

CASEY BARNES

2023 was a massive year for Casey Barnes, picking up Golden Guitar Award wins for Album of the Year and Top Selling Album of the Year for his latest album, *Light It Up*, along with the APRA Award for Most Performed Country Work for *God Took His Time On You*. ‘*Light It Up*’ also took out the 2022 ARIA Award for Best Country Album. Debuting #1 on the ARIA Australian Country Album chart and #3 on the All-Genre Australian Album chart, *Light It Up* features five smash hit singles including “Come Turn Me On”, ‘Get To Know Ya’ and the ARIA Gold sales accredited anthem, “God Took His Time On You”.

Produced by Melbourne based production team MSquared (Michael Delozrenzis and Michael Paynter), ‘*Light It Up*’ features ten new original songs, all co-written by Casey with MSquared and Nashville singer-songwriters Kaci Brown and Sam Gray. The album has spent over twenty months in the Top 20 of the ARIA Australian Country Album chart, while Casey’s catalogue has amassed over 60 million combined streams.

Casey’s electrifying live show has made him one of the most popular touring acts in Australian country and the massive ‘*Light It Up*’ Tour has taken him across Australia including festivals such as Bluesfest, CMC Rocks, Groundwater and Gympie Muster and to the U.S along where he showcased at CMA Fest.



Casey continued the heat in 2023, with ‘Boys Like Me’ and ‘Never Give Up On A Good Time’ both reaching #1 on the CountryTown Hot50 Airplay chart and closed the year with ‘Never Give Up On A Good Time’ picking up a sync on the promo spots for the ‘New Year’s Eve Live: Nashville Big Bash’ special on CBS in the U.S.

He is set to take his career to new heights in 2024, when he performs at Stagecoach in Indio, California. Casey is the only Australian artist included on the line-up for the world’s biggest ticketed country music festival to be held on the Coachella site in April. With a new album in works, a growing global fanbase and big touring plans, 2024 is sure to be Casey’s biggest year yet.

DAMNED SAM & THE PREACHERS

These road-worn and restless troubadours of the Ovens Valley lean as casually on their Americana influences as they would a gum tree at the river. Their sound is a nod to artists from Gram Parsons to Chris Stapleton, but their take on the genre is more a result of growing up in the bush than chasing gold records on Music Row.

Original songs; “Promising Dreams”, “Ovens Valley Pines” and “Victoria”, penned by founding member Sam McIntosh, speak to life’s familiar themes of being unlucky-in-love and to the awe-inspiring beauty of their native high country. They are the sound of long winding roads, the solace of the bush and the stories of people living in small towns in rural Australia.

McIntosh’s charismatic vocal performance is backed up by the electrified country boogie and twanging four-on-the-floor rock’n’roll of band mates, Greg Whitehead



(guitar/lapsteel), Max Hyland (Bull fiddle bass) and Chris Riley (Drum set), each bringing their personal influences, while kicking country music hallmarks with a well-worn Blundstone boot. Hats and boots optional; A Damned Sam & The Preachers show is not about the size of your buckle belt, or the love of a plaid Western shirt, you’ll be in fine company when you come just as you are.

JOE CAMILLERI AND THE BLACK SORROWS

Joe Camilleri is an undisputed icon of Australian music, who is marking the 40th anniversary of The Black Sorrows with his career 55th release – The Way We Do Business! Very few can make such claims. Joe’s seemingly tireless drive to record quality music has rewarded him legendary status and well-deserved longevity in the music industry. Add to this a massive tour bringing Sorrows’ hits and tomorrow’s classics to cities and towns nationwide. Since 1984, The Black Sorrows have toured Australia more times than anyone can remember, played sold out shows across Europe, won ARIA & APRA Awards, had multiple gold & platinum releases, and sold more than a million albums



worldwide. Joe’s a Hall of Famer and a rock n roll lifer. Camilleri has shown fans and critics alike that he is a prolific songwriter and performer with an undeniable energy and love of it all.

EUROGLIDERS

EUROGLIDERS, formed in 1981 in Perth, Australia, quickly became a global success with four albums, hit singles, and numerous awards. The band began as a love story between singer Grace Knight and songwriter Bernie Lynch, both with separate bands before merging into EUROGLIDERS. Their collaboration brought anthems like “Heaven” and “We Will Together,” leading to a string of chart-topping singles and albums.

In the following decade, the band gained international success, including a Billboard hit in the U.S. and MTV performances. After the 80s, Grace pursued a successful acting and jazz career, while Bernie worked in music and fashion. Despite a break, EUROGLIDERS reunited in 2006, releasing a new album and touring.

In 2015, they released *Don't Eat The Daisies*, blending new songs with reworked classics, followed by Grace's solo album *Fragile* in 2016, also featuring Bernie's



songwriting. Though no longer married, Grace and Bernie continue to share a deep friendship and passion for performing, embodying the enduring joy of music.

SUSSUDIO – THE ULTIMATE TRIBUTE TO PHIL COLLINS, GENESIS & FRIENDS

Phil Collins – One of music's most iconic and celebrated figures, legendary British singer, songwriter, drummer, and producer has made an indelible mark on pop culture during his five-decade-long career – both as a member of Genesis and as a chart-topping solo artist. Long counted as one of the world's all-time best-selling recording artists, the Rock and Roll Hall of Famer is also among its most decorated, with multiple GRAMMYS®, Ivor Novellos, BRITs, and an Academy Award to his name.

But what is perhaps more impressive is his ability to reach so many fans – across borders and generations – with a string of hits that have become ingrained in the collective consciousness, including “Against All Odds (Take a Look at Me Now),” “Sussudio,” “You'll Be in My Heart,” and, perhaps most famously, “In the Air Tonight,” which is not only one of the late 20th century's most enduring songs, but also features one of music's most recognisable drum breakdowns.

TAYLOR HENDERSON

Taylor Henderson became one of Australia's most loved artists in 2013 with his unique soothing tone, rising to fame on the nostalgic TV show where he came runner-up on The X Factor. Since then, Taylor has built an impressive career with over 30 million streams on Spotify, and a devoted social media following of 500k across his platforms.

His musical achievements are significant, with ARIA #1 and #5 charting albums, along with multiple Top 50 singles. He has graced stages across Australia, supporting renowned acts like MKTO on their national tour and headlining his own successful tours, both in Australia and internationally.

In 2022, Taylor had the honour of performing at the Commonwealth Games Closing Ceremony in the UK, alongside musical icons Vanessa Amorosi and Baker Boy, showcasing his global appeal.

More recently, Taylor embarked on his Changing Seasons tour across Australia, with performances in VIC, SA, TAS,



and WA, as he continues to connect with fans and solidify his place in the Australian music scene.

As he continues to evolve musically, Taylor is also hard at work on new music, with plans to release fresh tracks in the year ahead, promising to offer fans even more of his emotive songwriting and captivating vocals.

Ranging from ballads to a jumping dance floor, while everyone sings and grooves along to their favourite hits of the 70's, 80's, 90's, Carmen and Michael are the Funk, RnB and soul aficionados. These two know how to read a crowd and bring the party to the party.



THIRSTY MERC

THIRSTY MERC are unquestionably one of Australia's finest live acts.

Having released 4 critically acclaimed albums, over 250,000 album sales under their belt, a finalist in the APRA Song of the Year for 20 Good Reasons (which also reached #1 on iTunes in Australia), 5 ARIA Award nominations, **Thirsty Merc** have found their way into the fabric of Australia's musical landscape.

Thirsty Merc formed in Sydney in 2002 releasing their debut EP, *First Work*, in September 2003, before being signed to Warner Music. The band's big break came in 2004 with the release of their debut, self titled, album which included the hits, *Someday Someday* and *In The Summertime* (the theme for *Bondi Rescue* since 2006). Two more studio albums followed - *Slideshow* in 2007 (#4 ARIA Album) and *Mousetrap Heart* in 2010 (#14 on the ARIA Album chart) which included radio staples, *20 Good Reasons*, *Mousetrap Heart* and *Tommy and Krista*.

Thirsty Merc marked the 10-year milestone since the release of their selftitled, double platinum debut LP with the announcement of their Acoustic Anniversary Album and national tour. Dubbed 'AAA' the album is a collection of acoustic interpretations of fan favourites. These recordings showcase the band's exemplary level of musicianship and hearing these well-known songs with acoustic production highlights the worldclass song writing ability of Rai Thistlethwayte. In 2015,



Thirsty Merc released *Shifting Gears*, their first wholly independent and first new material in five years, and spent the next 18 months crossing the country on 3 extensive tours, running up thousands of Frequent Flyer points and sold out shows. The first single *The Good Life* was nominated for Rock Work Of The Year at the 2017 APRA awards.

In 2018 the band released their debut live album simply entitled '**Thirsty Merc LIVE!**' and in 2021 dropped '**Celebration**' which features re-imagined classic tracks from legendary Australian artists. **Thirsty Merc** embarked on a massive anniversary campaign aptly named the '**20 Good Years**' tour in 2023 with many of the accompanying gigs reaching sold out status. Most recently the band has announced 22 shows starting in late 2024 under an all new '**Electric Summer**' concept, boasting an itinerary which covers all major markets and includes an extensive regional component to the travels.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

ARE THERE ANY AGE RESTRICTIONS?

The Brighter Days Festival is a family-friendly event without age restrictions.

WHERE IS THE RESERVED SEATING?

Reserved seating is at the front behind the 'chair-free' area roped off for dancing.

HOW DO I PICK UP MY TICKET I BOUGHT ONLINE?

You will simply have your ticket barcode (printed or on your device) scanned and show your ID at the gate to collect your tamperproof wristband. You may then come and go from the festival precinct as you like. Please note: All patrons must be wearing a wristband to enter the precinct.

IS THERE FOOD AVAILABLE AT THE FESTIVAL?

The Brighter Days Festival Food Court will be operating all weekend, from Friday 4.00pm with a variety of food and drink options for all the family.

WHERE CAN I PURCHASE MERCHANDISE AT THE EVENT?

The 2025 BDF Merchandise will be available from the Merchandise Shed, in the festival precinct from Friday night at 4.00pm, then Saturday and Sunday from 9.00am until sold out.

AM I ABLE TO BRING MY OWN CHAIR TO THE FESTIVAL?

Yes, feel free to bring your own chairs and picnic rugs. There is a 'chair-free' exclusion zone front of stage. You may leave your chairs at the precinct overnight at your own risk, and provided you leave the space around them rubbish free. You must take your chair home with you at the end of the event.

CAN I BRING ALCOHOL TO THE BRIGHTER DAYS FESTIVAL?

No, BYO is not permitted. Alcohol is available for purchasing from within the festival. The Brighter Days Festival is a no glass event. All proceeds from the sale of alcohol, after costs, go to support the Brighter Days Foundation.

WILL THERE BE SAFETY AND SECURITY?

Yes. The Brighter Days Festival has security patrols and local police presence. A manned First Aid tent will be in operation over the three days.

WHAT WILL HAPPEN IN THE CASE OF WET WEATHER?

Our outdoor stage will go ahead rain, hail or shine unless the weather has been deemed dangerous or risking public safety. In the unlikely event that any/all parts of the Festival is to be cancelled an announcement will be made on site and through our social media channels.

ARE THERE PUBLIC TOILETS?

Yes, public toilets are located at various locations within the Festival precinct and will be well sign posted.

IS THERE ANY PUBLIC TRANSPORT?

Yes, charter buses Friday evening, all day Saturday and Sunday to and from Harrierville & Freeburgh, Myrtleford and Wandiligong. See our website or Facebook for details.

IS THERE A SHUTTLE BUS TO BRIGHT TOWNSHIP?

Yes, there are 3 shuttle bus loops. Bright EAST, Bright WEST & POREPUNKAH. More details on page 20.

IS THERE PARKING AT THE FESTIVAL?

Yes, there is plenty of free parking at the Festival, and you are welcome to leave your car if you need to. (Please note there is no camping in cars or in the festival precinct allowed).

CAN I BRING MY DOG?

Sorry, only accredited service animals permitted within the Festival precinct. Patrons will be required to show animals' accreditation to gain entry.
